Perhaps it is because St Luke travelled so much with St Paul that he speaks so much about journeys in his Gospel. His Gospel is the story of Jesus making his way to Jerusalem. From there, in his Church, Jesus travels through all the world.



First Reading

Baruch 5:1-9

When we sin, we build up mountains of separation between ourselves.

Second Reading

Philippians 1:4-6. 8-11

Prayer is a sort of movement out into the world, filling it with joy.

Gospel

Luke 3:1-6

From the empty spaces of the desert, a voice is heard through all the world. John the Baptist still speaks to us.

Responsorial Psalm

What marvels the Lord worked for us! Indeed we were glad.

Diocesan restructuring

I regret that last weekend I failed to supply you all with a copy of the booklet describing the present stage of progress towards a newly ordered Diocese. There are plenty of copies available today so please make sure that every house has one. Some are finding the practical proposals frightening; some are much disturbed. A casual look at the proposal to form a partnership of Wanstead, South-Woodford and Woodford Green suggests little change. It will be a disaster if we fall into that error. We can be much helped by John the Baptist's arrival on the Advent scene today. Luke carefully sets him in his political and historical context. The Good News that is coming is to unfold in the real world with its goodness and evil mixed. The important thing is that we do not settle into doing nothing. We have to change our understanding of what our church is, and of our part in it. Listen to John and tell me what we can start in motion once Christmas is past.

There will be an array of priests to choose from tomorrow when you come tomorrow evening to prepare for Christmas. Take your pick. It is a good opportunity to take a look at where you are with the Lord, and where your life is going: to affirm what is good and to see what can be better. Try it.
