

## Fr Boniface

Came to our country in 1938 as a childrefugee from the growing Nazi menace. He was much looking forward to his 90<sup>th</sup> birthday and 70<sup>th</sup> year of Franciscan profession this year. Last Monday God called him to heaven for a much richer celebration of these milestones than we could have given him. Boniface served church and Franciscans well. He was teacher, librarian, protocol manager of the central Franciscan admin in Rome and pastoral priest. He was also a valued brother, sometimes a little "eccentric"? but much loved.

## Boniface' funeral

We will receive him into church at 5pm on Tuesday and together pray the evening prayer of the day for the dead. There will be no mass at 10am on Wednesday. His funeral mass will be at 11am and then he will be buried with many others friars in St Patrick's cemetery in Stratford. Refreshments will be provided in Becket, liberally as always, by our parish CWL.
