Guide notes

- 1. If you make a declaration by telephone or email, you will receive a copy of the declaration.
- 2. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the Parish Office.
- 3. If your circumstances change, and you no longer pay enough tax to cover the amount, please contact the Parish Office.
- 4. Higher rate taxpayers can claim back the difference between basic rate and higher rate tax. If you pay Income tax at the higher rate, you can claim further tax relief via your Self-Assessment tax return.
- 5. Please notify the Parish Office if you change your name or address.
- 6. Gift Aid is linked to basic tax rate. Basic rate tax is currently 20%, which allows charities to reclaim 25pence in the pound.
- 7. Please request the Annual Statement for each tax year by emailing Parish Office.
