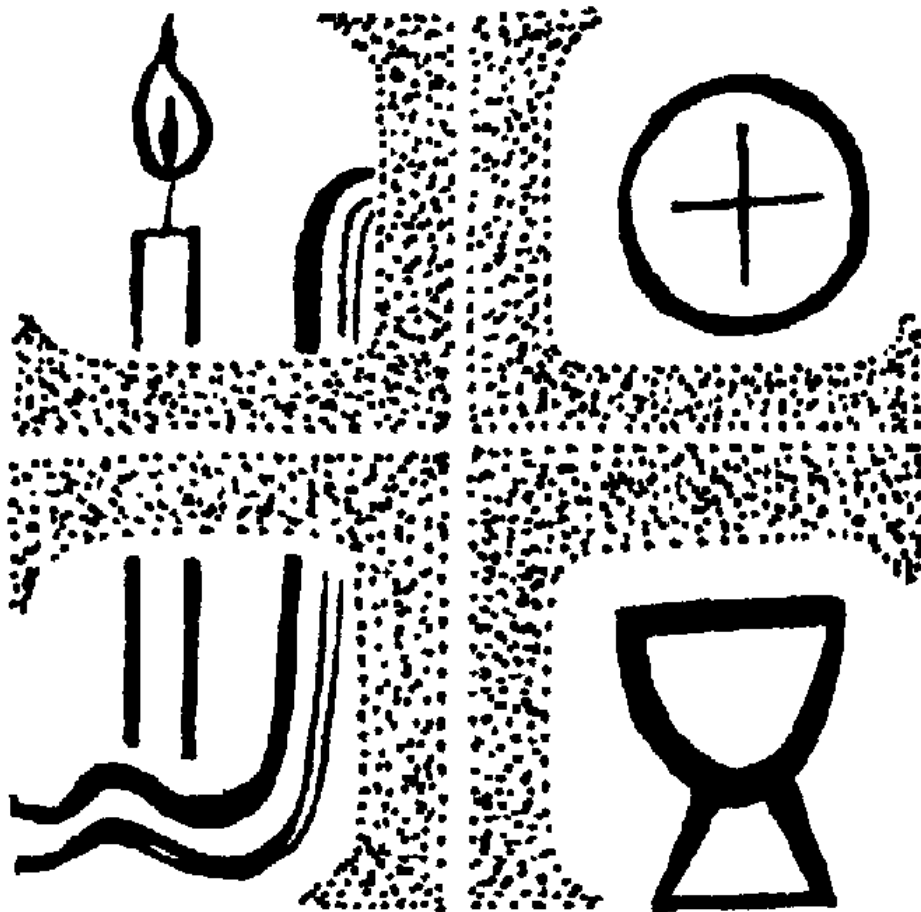


# St. Thomas of Canterbury Catholic Church

First Holy Communion 2020  
Programme Application





Children joining the programme will be placed into two groups and they **must** attend 8 sessions on Saturday mornings from 10am to 12noon during term time. Each child will receive a book which will cover work done at each session and work to be done at home.

**A 100% attendance is required and if any child misses 2 sessions they will have to start the programme the following year.**

- **Group A will begin on Sat 28th September**
- **Group B will begin on Sat 5th October**

We can only run this programme if we have parents willing to be volunteers. This means being prepared to help on 8 Saturday mornings from September to March. This is a big commitment but is very rewarding. It involves working with groups of about 8 children under the guidance of the lead catechist who will prepare the work to be done.

The first meeting for **ALL** parents and carers will be on **Wednesday 18th September 2019** at 7pm in the Becket Centre to discuss the content of the programme, dates for group sessions and First Communion.

The information on this enrolment form will be used to produce the 1st Communion certificate. We will only accept children from our Parish who have been baptised and who will be going into school year 3 in September 2019. Children NOT baptised at St Thomas' will need to attach a copy of their baptismal certificate

Please enclose a cheque (or cash) for £20 payable to *St Thomas of Canterbury Parish Account*, to cover the costs of materials used on the course. If you would like a parent book that accompanies the programme please add £8 to your payment. No child shall be excluded for financial reasons so if you have any concerns please contact the parish office.
