Today begins the season known as Ordinary Time, but even in Ordinary Time the Lord is as close as ever to bless us with word and sacrament.


First Reading Isaiah 49:3. 5-6 In this, the second of the "Servant Songs", a mysterious servant is called upon to be a light to the nations.
