2019-2020 Chair's Annual Report of the Parish Pastoral Council (PPC)

It has been quite a difficult and rather frustrating time for the PPC. The year started off well with an "Away day" at Chigwell in August which all council members attended and concluded with good intentions to a) try and make the Parish more welcoming b) work on issues regarding the youth of the Parish c) Communication issues.

The issue of the lack of activities for the youth in the parish is not unique to STOC and initially we hoped to work together on this with the other parishes in the Parish Partnership. This did not prove feasible as each had different viewpoints so we decided to go it alone and plan some youth events later in the year. By February though the Covid pandemic was on the horizon and by March we were in lockdown. Since then all activities have been frozen.

Mental Health was also high on our agenda and we did manage to arrange an excellent well attended lecture on the topic just before lockdown occurred though subsequent talks had to be cancelled. Fortunately a volunteer's event was held with great success earlier in the year before the Becket Centre closed down.

Many meetings have taken place on fabric issues - the roofing has now been finished and work on the new heating system was at an advanced stage before that too was paused. Currently we are trying to restart this and have the heating installed as soon as possible.

A Health and Safety team was formed last year mainly to deal with issues that our insurers had drawn our attention to regarding the safety of Staff, Friars and Parishioners. At the time we did not realise that within months it would be needed in a pandemic! The safety measures introduced in March and updated on an almost weekly level since are directly due to the team supported by the Parish Office.

Whilst the Parish Council is in dire need of enthusiastic new members it is not the main source of activity in the Parish. There are many groups and individuals in the parish where the real work is done, all involved in diverse activities such as youth activities, sacramental and pastoral work, cleaning, fund raising, maintenance, IT and Mass Streaming, evaluating services provided to the parish (Phones, Utilities etc.) and many other good works. To try and name all is impossible as there are so many but our thanks to them all and also the Parish Office staff who seem to be involved in just about everything.

Sadly we will not be having an AGM this year due to Covid Restrictions but should parishioners have any ideas, questions or advice they wish to give to members of the PPC please do write to us via the mail below and we will reply.
