Reflections on 2nd Sunday -John's Gospel (2 :1--11) The Wedding at Cana in Galilee.

"This was the first of the signs given by Jesus-he let his glory be seen and his disciples believed in him"

In John's Gospel we get a graphic account of the 1st public miracle by Jesus . It showed the power of the Lord over natural elements—pre-figuring the Eucharist -and also the influence of Mary over his decisions. After a rather brusque answer to her statement that "they have no wine ", he really reconsiders his response and goes ahead to prevent an otherwise embarrassing situation developing into a minor tragedy and possibly a future gossiping talking point around the newly -weds lack of provision for their guests ! What keen observation and thoughtfulness by Our Lady in this scenario.

There's humour too—when the chief steward -obviously a wine connoisseur –recognises the quality of the second servings—and upbraids the bridegroom on his delay in serving the best wine first!

Perhaps our disciples realised that they were on to a good thing with Jesus---he was a good leader who provided them abundantly with "wine -to make them joyous", and " bread that satisfied"!
