Second Reading 1 Corinthians 12:3-7. 12-13


The apostle Paul reflects on the gifts of the Spirit in the lives of believers and encourages us to play our part, whatever that may be, in building up the life of our community.

Ministers of Holy Communion

I thank the 24 Ministers who came to the renewal sessions in the past two weeks. It is an essential part of this central ministry of our parish that we spend time with the Lord we bring to you. And it is good to share this prayer to keep our service full.

We bring communion every week to individuals in their own homes. We also bring it to those in the Care Homes of the parish. When any of your family – or your acquaintance – take up residence in one of these Homes do please tell us so that we can bring them communion. Confidentiality laws now prevent information of religious practice to be shared. While sick persons receive care for their bodies there is an even greater need of ministry for their spirit. Do keep us informed so that we can give it. And remember the sacrament for the sick.

Ordinary time

In the church's liturgy Eastertide ends today and we move into Ordinary Time. The yearly cycle is resumed with week 8 in the Divine Office with Psalter week 4. The readings at mass are also from week 8 of the first yearly cycle and on Sundays we follow cycle A with the gospel of Matthew.

We can experience a slight sense of disappointment at this return to the ordinary. There are several major feasts that help in the immediate weeks. Lent and Easter have provided us in the Masses and Divine Office with a rich menu carefully chosen from all parts of the bible. These have led us a little deeper into understanding and sharing what Jesus did from the beginning of his active life in the desert to his return to the Father. Pentecost ends this abruptly but the Holy Spirit has taken over. On his presence and gifts we now rely. Today we congratulate our 4 adults receiving the sacrament of confirmation. The families of the younger candidates are preparing for their sacrament in ten days time.
