

31st March 2019

Lent is an ideal time for us to draw closer to God. This is a season to reflect upon the direction our lives have taken and perhaps repent of some aspects. God always gives us a second chance to live fruitful lives in the love of God.

## Easter Vigil Mass

It is dramatic. We start in the dark, for Jesus in the tomb and very dead. In this chilling remembrance we go back in history to the start of creation. What is God doing? We read the story of the 6 days of creation. At each stage of God's work we sing out: And God saw that it was **Good**. And **very good** when it comes to Adam and Eve.

Still in the dark we listen to the story of people of Israel who were led by a column of cloud by day and a column of fire by night. So, in the dark church a fire springs up two or three feet high, (fire extinguishers at the ready though, quite safe) to focus us on the old journey and realise it is happening to us, on our journey from baptism.

# Major refurbishment

You know your homes need regular maintenance. Through the years the Church, Friary and the rest have received this regular attention. But some more areas that have served us long are now crying for replacement. We are about to embark on the first stage of a major renewal of the property. The roof tiles, probably 130 years old, are cracked and many held together with sticking plaster. We did renew most of the church roof when in 1976 we reordered the church. Work will begin this month to replace the tiles on the Friary and chapels not yet restored. It will include bringing insulation up to present standards.
